That Prestonsburg high school needs and should have a gymnasium in connection with the school is the stand which this newspaper takes.

Now—those who have for so long been talking about this matter, speak out loud and go to the proper authorities and solicit their support in this movement.

There are those who condemn the place occupied by athletics in the schools of today. They, like the blind men of Afghanistan, are partly right and just as much wrong. It would be folly for us to deny that in many instances' athletics are over-emphasized in schools to the detriment of the scholastic achievements of the students.

But we contend that, under the present regime, patrons of Prestonsburg high school need entertain no fears on that score. Mr. Triplett, superintendent of city schools, and his faculty have always insisted upon scholastic work above all else.

Athletics conducted on a sane basis in any school increases school spirit, makes for a healthy condition mentally, spiritually and physically in the student body and offers the greatest bar to the cultivation of idle habits on the part of boys and girls.

Prestonsburg high school has, in Julian Harlowe, an athletic coach whose ability is unquestioned and whose example as a "good sport" and clean athlete is an inspiration to the youths who come under his tutelage. Other schools covet his services. It is up to us to go ahead with what inevitably must be our task at some time and give Mr. Harlowe the encouragement that he and the school so richly deserve.

BACK TO THE FARM!

Only a repetition of last year's disastrous drought will prevent Floyd county from producing this year a far greater volume of farm products than ever before.

For the past fifteen years Floyd county's population has drifted toward "public works." For a time such work was plentiful, miners earned good wages, there was no dearth of employment. Now, unfortunately as it may be, the coal industry is tottering, the demand for miners is small and other forms of "public works" are only occasional in this section.

So the cry is, "Back to the Farm!" It is well that it is so. Workers of the soil seem to draw from nature some of its lasting qualities, seem to lose some of the sordidness which comes from being crammed up together in labor camps. This county can use more good citizens. And it is certain that, barring catastrophic drought, our farmers will not starve—which is no little consolation.




NATIVE FLOYD WOMAN DIES IN BOYD COUNTY



Floyd Men Testify in Pike Murder Trial Last Week at Pikeville

Frank Newsome, charged jointly with his two brothers, Taulbee and Natch, with the murder of Rollins on Cross, Pike county, of Kent, Mitchell, one of Pikeville, was convicted of manslaughter, and sentenced to five years Saturday and given a five-year probationary sentence.

Dr. W. L. Stumbo, Floyd county doctor, was used as a corroborative witness in the trial. Dr. Stumbo testified that he saw Mitchell arrive at Big Mill Creek, the scene of the murder, and that he saw Mitchell and Natch there.

Mitchell and his brother, Andy, were accused of having killed Newsome, father, Cato Newsome, several years ago, according to Deputy Sheriff J. H. Childers.

Both Natch Newsome and Taulbee corroborated the testimony of the doctor. Taulbee, who is under a two-year sentence, said he fired both shots from his pistol, a .41-caliber and that it shot either .38 or .41 cartridges and that he carried both.
