

Since the Betsy Layne High School was destroyed by fire the school has continued in this temporary structure. Plans for a new and modernly equipped building are now in the hands of the architect.



GYMNASIUM

A HISTORY OF BETSY LAYNE HIGH SCHOOL

This marks the twelfth year of the existence of the Betsy Layne High School. In September of 1925, Mr. Ishmael Triplett began teaching thirty students the basal subjects of algebra, English, history and science. All of the students were housed in one room of the Pike-Floyd Coal Company Building. The following year Mr. F. A. Maggard succeeded Mr. Triplett as Principal.

In January of 1927, a ten room brick building was erected and dedicated as the Betsy Layne High School. Two new teachers were added to the high school fac-

ulty thus bringing the total to three.

The period between 1928 and 1930 was one of expansion. During this time the first graduation was held. A new gymnasium replaced the old skating rink and Betsy Layne soon became known as the home of winning basketball teams. One of the most important additions was that of a band. Through the untiring efforts of Mr. Jesse Elliot, the band organization ranks as the best in this section. A little later both boys' and girls' glee clubs were added in addition to the installation of a well equipped home economics department.

Mr. Maggard continued as principal until 1934 when he was succeeded by Mr. Maurice Baker. The following year Mr. Baker was replaced by Mr. B. E. Lewis who was followed by Mr. Delmon Howard who holds the


position at present.
